## Financial and Other Commitments

Through the years, SSC has evolved into the finest competitive swim program in Oklahoma. The attention given by our coaches has created an excellent atmosphere for the development of young swimmers. Commitment to quality does not come without cost. Retaining availability of a pool and qualified coaching requires year around leases and high fixed costs. We provide our excellent coaching staff with competitive compensation for their many hours of dedication. These issues create a constant monthly expense and are just two of the numerous expenses incurred on an ongoing basis. In order to maintain a quality swim team, each of us must be willing to make certain commitments. SSC hosts 1 to 2 swim meets per year that provide us the potential to earn significant additional funds with which to operate the team. Without the additional funds generated by these swim meets and other fundraisers, membership dues would be significantly higher. A well-run swim meet requires a large number of volunteers. Spread out over the entire membership, this amounts to 3-8 hours per meet per family. Some needed tasks require little or no training (concessions, hospitality, timing). Others require specialized training (officiating, computer operations). All are necessary to host a well-run meet. A meet that is not well run will not be well attended and will eventually cease to exist. We urge each family to volunteer whatever time they can, when they can, to make this the most rewarding experience possible for the swimmers. These commitments are as follows:

## Service Hours

A well-run organization requires a large numbers of volunteers. Each family should be prepared to work the specified number of hour. There are numerous opportunities to fulfill this obligation over the two swim seasons.

The hours required are determined by level of your swimmer: Beginning in January, each family will be required to provide **15 hours** of club service.

If you have more than one swimmer, the number of hours required is determined by the swimmer in the highest level. At the end of the Long Course season in August, you will be assessed **\$10.00 per hour** for each hour not completed during the year. Some needed tasks require little or no training (concessions, hospitality, timing). Others require specialized training (officiating, computer operations). All are necessary to host a well-run meet.

## How will I know when to work?

Prior to each meet SSC hosts; an email will go out announcing the areas where help is needed. If one area is filled, you will be referred to another area in need of volunteers. The major areas are:

- Timing
- Concessions
- Hospitality
- Heat Sheet Sales
- Awards
- Officials (training and certification is available)
- Swim-a-thon
- Clinics
- Festival of Giving
- Club Officer
- Committee Assignments
- Other opportunities as they arise

Items purchased and donated to Concessions/Hospitality will be credited toward your service hours as long as the receipt is turned into the head of each area. (Example: If you donate \$20.00 in food, your hours are reduced by 2).

## **Dues**

SSC depends upon prompt payment of monthly dues in order to meet the club's financial obligations for coach's salaries, pool rental, taxes and travel. In order to meet these obligations, dues must be received by the 10th of each month for that swimming period. Payments received after the 20th are subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Dues are based on an annual fee, which is broken down into monthly installments for the convenience of our members. Dues are to be paid monthly. Dues and other fees are NOT prorated for partial periods EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF NEW SSC MEMBERS. If you have any questions about your dues or if there is a change in the swimmer's status, please contact a club official. The following rates reflect monthly and annual charges: ALL RATES SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

- Minnows \$40 per month
- Dolphins \$45 per month
- Barracudas \$55 per month
- Sharks \$55 per month
- High School Students participating in SSC related meets \$60 per year (\$30 per semester)
- A once per year registration fee of \$35 (\$50 maximum per family). This will be collected in January
- USA Swimming registration fee of \$49 annually. A copy of the swimmers birth certificate is required.

Parents with more than one swimmer may reduce the monthly fee for each additional swimmer over the first swimmer by \$5.00 per swimmer. All Swimmers must have a valid USA Swimming Registration before participating in any club activities.

**SWIMMERS WHO ARE BEHIND IN ANY PAYMENTS FOR 45 DAYS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE WATER UNTIL PAYMENTS ARE BROUGHT TO A CURRENT STATUS.**

### **Reinstatement Fees:**

When member families discontinue paying monthly dues, unless the swimmer is injured and incapable of participating in SSC, the swimmer forfeits their membership. A physician's letter will be required to validate injuries. Reinstatement occurs when the member family remits the equivalent of one month's dues per swimmer to be reinstated. This figure is capped at the equivalent of the 2 swimmers paying the highest monthly dues for families with more than 2 swimmers.

### **Quitting the Team:**

Swimmers wishing to leave the team must submit a written statement 30 days before leaving. Member families are reminded that SSC incurs pool and coaching expenses for hours these resources are utilized, not based on the number of active swimmers. Our annual budget is developed based on the number of active swimmers at the end of each season along with assumptions about adding swimmers, losing swimmers, pool time required, and coaching required. We are obligated to pay for the pool time and coaching salaries associated with these contracts. Consequently, the loss of dues over an extended period of time creates a severe financial hardship for SSC.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Q: What is Sooner Swim Club (SSC)?**

**A:** SSC welcomes swimmers of all capabilities and is primarily structured to enable individuals to accomplish their individual goals within a team environment.

### **Q: How is SSC structured?**

**A:** SSC provides a well rounded, quality, competitive swimming program for young people of all ages and swimming abilities. There are a total of 3 programs available for abilities ranging from Pre-competitive (novice competitors generally 6 to 8 years of age) through the high school age swimmers, where the focus is on success at National competitive levels.

### **Q: How do we obtain information about practice and meet schedules?**

**A:** For information concerning the swim club schedule and all team activities, SSC maintains a comprehensive website (<http://soonerswimclub.org/>). We also send information via e-mail. **Checking your e-mail and the website frequently is strongly recommended.**

### **Q: How is the business of administrating SSC handled?**

**A:** SSC is a nonprofit organization. The only paid employees are our coaches. Kent Nicholson, head coach, has supervisory responsibility for the entire swim program and day-to-day operations. Jenny Crow, Travis Danley and Valerie Halverson are assistant coaches. SSC consists of a Board of Directors with elections held annually in September for President-elect, Treasurer, Secretary, and At-Large Members. Other board positions are appointed as needed. The SSC Board of Directors serves to monitor and review club operations, including problems, which may arise. The Board is responsible for the coaching staff, including evaluations, hiring, terminations, compensation, and contractual arrangements. Parents are invited and encouraged to attend the monthly Board of Directors meeting held during practice at the swim complex. Please refer to the monthly calendar for the date.

### **Q: What are SSC's obligations and how does SSC support itself?**

**A:** The Board of Directors provides pool availability through contracts with The University of Oklahoma, coaching staff (including coaches' education, certification, and travel expenses) and pool equipment as necessary to support club activities. The coaching staff provides organized practices and professional swimming technique, training and instruction to provide the best opportunity for your child's swimming success. SSC supports itself through membership fees and fundraising activities, primarily organizing and running swim meets.

### **Q: What is USA Swimming Membership and why is it required?**

**A:** As a USA Swimming licensed swim club, SSC is obligated to ensure all swimmers are members of USA Swimming, Inc. It is also necessary for participation in any USA sanctioned swim meet. USA Swimming provides SSC liability insurance in the event of an accident, and the swimmers medical insurance to cover catastrophic medical costs incurred during a sanctioned activity, including SSC practices and activities. **No swimmer will be allowed in the pool without USA Swimming Membership.**

### **Q: What are the swimmer's obligations to SSC?**

**A:** Swimmers are athlete members of Oklahoma Swimming (OKS) and USA Swimming, Inc. Their primary obligations are to enjoy themselves, make new friends, practice hard, attain their swimming goals and conduct themselves as young ladies and men in accordance with SSC and USA Codes of Conduct.

### **Q: What are parental obligations to SSC?**

**A:** Parent's most important obligation is to provide constant encouragement to your child. Additionally, parents are considered active SSC members and are invited to attend board meetings and hold office. Providing quality swim instruction and water time for your children requires a time commitment, in addition to the fees paid. All SSC members are *unpaid volunteers* who also hold down full time jobs, limiting their availability for SSC responsibilities. As a result, their willingness to work together and rely on one another is paramount to SSC success.

### **Q: How can I become more involved?**

**A:** Talk to any SSC officer or board member, any of our coaches or your pool representative. Officers and coaches are listed on the SSC website. (<http://soonerswimclub.org/>)

**Q: I have other obligations as well. Why should I volunteer?**

**A:** The larger the number of volunteers the less of a burden on any individual. Moreover, most of the personnel you observe at meets, while committed to provide whatever is required, have senior swimmers and will phase their participation out over the next few years as their children move on to college. There are very few, if any, age group parents positioning themselves to take over. Frankly, the ability of any volunteer organization to prosper depends directly on the involvement of members of the organization. The overwhelming majority of this commitment is through the Board of Directors and swim meets. The best reason to volunteer may very well be that volunteers have a better understanding of SSC's internal operations and the rules under which we function during a swim meet, have better access to their children on deck, and are closer to the competition. We are at the meets, why not contribute to the success of the club and have more access to your child at the same time?

**Q: Can I specify what I volunteer for?**

**A:** Certainly. Each of us has certain talents and attributes which, when put to proper use, would benefit SSC. We also gain personal satisfaction in different ways. There is obviously more value to each of us as individuals, and the club in general, if we can volunteer for activities we will enjoy and will benefit the club at the same time.

**Q: Why do we need so many volunteers at a swim meet?**

**A:** It is important to first understand that the primary purpose of officials and timers at a meet is to ensure compliance with the technical rules of swimming, provide a safe venue, and ensure that no one individual has an advantage over another, in other words, to ensure a level playing field. Other functions - awards, announcer, concessions, and hospitality provide encouragement, information and sustenance to everyone in attendance.

**Q: I still have questions. Who can I contact for more information?**

**A:** Talk to any SSC officer or board member, any of our coaches or your pool representative. Again, officers and coaches are listed on the SSC website.

## **History of Sooner Swim Club**

Sooner Swim Club (SSC) was founded 40 years ago in 1963 by a group of Norman parents, among them Henry Enterline and Donald and Jane Menzie, who wrote the bylaws and designed the logo. The club from the beginning was a part of the national swimming organization under its various names--now United States Swimming (USS).

The club was formed to promote a love of swimming as a sport and healthy lifestyle among young people. Under SSC auspices, children and adolescents were taught to swim competitively and provided access to all reaches of the sport. From early on, SSC produced notable swimmers, several of whom achieved state records, among them Michael Yoch, Joe Poe, Adam Przebinda, Brian and Lauren Howell, and Chris Shields; and even one member of the 1980 Olympic team, Kirt Fredericks.

SSC originally trained at and maintained what was known as the South Base pool, and indoors at the Field House Pool until these closed several years ago. SSC then began to lease pool time from the University of Oklahoma Murray Case-Sells Swim Complex. 100's of Norman area children have participated over the years. The club has grown from less than two dozen in the early years to well over 120 today.

## **SOONER SWIM CLUB CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT**

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this code is to promote the best possible team and individual impression at all times, and to acknowledge each person's responsibilities as a member of our team.

### **I. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:**

I, as a member of the SOONER SWIM CLUB, understand and will comply with the following guidelines as set forth by UNITED STATES SWIMMING, the OKLAHOMA SWIMMING COMMITTEE, and the SOONER SWIM CLUB.

### **II. GENERAL CONDUCT:**

**A.** All participating team members shall abide by this CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT.

**B.** Team members will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward all coaches, officials, administrators, fellow competitors and the public. This includes promptly following instructions at practice times, meets and any team sponsored activities.

**C.** Team members will refrain from any illegal or inappropriate behavior (vandalism, non-payment, etc.) that would detract from a positive image of the SOONER SWIM CLUB or be detrimental to its performance objectives.

**D.** The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, fireworks or controlled substances by an athlete during any team activity is prohibited.

**E.** Every SSC swimmer is entitled to participate in a safe, supportive environment. As such, no athlete, parent or relative shall engage in activities intended to harm or intimidate any SSC swimmer. Any person found guilty of attacking a swimmer whether through verbal, physical or any other means, shall be subject to sanction by the SSC Board of Directors. This may include suspension of practice privileges, disallowance of meet entry, or in extreme cases, termination of a member athlete from SSC in those instances in which the athlete, parent or other relative has been found to have interfered with the training or competition of another member athlete. Athletes, parents or relatives of swimmers who have been found guilty may receive formal sanction from the SSC Board of Directors and may additionally be barred from attendance at practices or meets.

**F.** Any additional guidelines for SOONER SWIM CLUB members will be established by the coaches and the Board of Directors as needed.

### **III. IMPLEMENTATION:**

**A.** All team members are apprised in writing of this policy. Signature of the document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with the CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT of the SOONER SWIM CLUB.

**B.** An evaluation system will be established to determine if team members have followed all aspects of the policy.

**C.** Failure to comply with the CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT as set forth in this document for the SOONER SWIM CLUB may result in disciplinary action under the provisions set forth.

### **IV. VIOLATION OF THE CODE:**

Such disciplinary action may include, but not be limited to:

**A.** Immediate dismissal from any SOONER SWIM CLUB activity.

**B.** Suspension or dismissal from all SOONER SWIM CLUB activities.

**C.** Responsibility to pay any damages or make any type of suitable compensation for applicable actions.

**D.** A review by the OKS REVIEW COMMITTEE and possible suspension from OKLAHOMA SWIMMING (or possibly UNITED STATES SWIMMING, if appropriate).

I hereby agree to abide by the rules of conduct set forth in Part II above and acknowledge that, should I violate any provisions of Part II, I will be subject to disciplinary action as set forth in Part IV, including suspension and/or dismissal.

**This release also includes practices and SSC team sponsored activities in which parents are absent, should a medical emergency arise.**
