FACILITIES: Fifty-meter course. Controlled temperatures. Eight lanes with non-turbulent lane lines. Electronic timing system. Large spectator seating area, swimmers rest area and diving well available for warm-up and cool down.

ELIGIBILITY: This meet is open to all registered USA Swimming athletes. Age as of the first day of the meet, June 20, 2008 will determine eligibility for an age group.

DISABILITIES: Chesapeake Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Please alert the Meet Director to any accommodations that may be required at the entry deadline.

FORMAT:

This is a dual session meet with a full menu of events, including relays. The format is designed to limit the time of competition to four hours for swimmers twelve and under. Relays will be at the beginning of each session. Each session's events will be seeded together by gender and scored by age group. Ribbons will be given in the following age groups: 8-U, 9-10 and 11-12. Team scoring will be provided and will include 8-U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 and Senior.

The 1500 Free, the 400 Free both 12-under on Friday night and Open 400 Free on Saturday afternoon, and 400IM will be swum fast to slow, alternating women and men. POSITIVE CHECK IN IS REQUIRED FOR ALL THESE EVENTS. FAILURE TO SHOW AFTER A COMPLETING A POSITIVE "CHECK IN" WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF THE NEXT INDIVIDUAL EVENT. AFTER THE CLOSING OF THE POSITIVE CHECK IN PERIOD EACH EVENT WILL BE DECK SEEDED. The 1500 Freestyle, 12- Under 400 Freestyle, the Open 400 Freestyle, and the Open 400 IM will be seeded by gender, awarded and scored as listed in the meet information. See below special instructions concerning timers for the distance events.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

The 1st heat, which will be the fastest heat of the freestyle distance events (1500's and the 400 Frees) for both men and women will be swum with 1 swimmer per lane. In order to give the maximum number of swimmers an opportunity to swim, and depending on the number of entries received, the club may elect to swim 2 swimmers per lane for the remaining heats of the 1500's and the 400 Free (with the exception of the 12& Under 400 Free which will be swum with only one swimmer per lane).

If this is done for example, the 2nd & 3rd heats of the men's and the 2nd & 3rd heats of women's 1500's would be in the water at the same time with two swimmers per lane. Swimmers will start from different ends of the pool on a staggered basis. Swimmer's will start out on the right side of the lane and will stay on that side the entire length of the race. Swimmer's starting from the start end of the pool will be assigned the east side (bleachers side) of the lane, with swimmer's who start from the turn end assigned the west side (classroom side) of the lane. Lap counters for the start end of the pool will be in their normal position at the turn end of the pool with lap counters for starts from the turn end of the pool at the start end of the pool. Race times will be recorded manually with two hand held stop watch times for each swimmer. The official time will be the average of the two. The meet referee will advise the coaches, during the coaches meeting before each session, what the protocol will be for that session's distance events.

All of the sprint events 50 meters by stroke will be started from the deep end of the pool and swam toward the turn (or scoreboard) end of the pool.

Chesapeake Swim Club will provide timers for the 1st & 2nd Heat of Women and the 1st & 2nd Heat of Men for the Open 1500 Free, the Open 400 Free and the Open 400 I.M. Athletes seeded 17th and below will be expected to provide their own timers. Participants swimming time trials are instructed to provide their own timers.

WARM UP INFORMATION: Daily swimmer counts permitting, Teams assigned the earlier warm-up period on Friday & Saturday will be assigned the later warm-up period on Sunday, and teams assigned the later warm-up Friday & Saturday will be assigned the earlier warm-up on Sunday. OKS and OCCC warm-up procedures will be followed. Coaches will maintain control of all activities in their warm-up lanes.

STARTS and SPRINTS: Starts and Sprints will be conducted at the same time as referenced above. **Lanes 1&8 will be dedicated to pace work, Lanes 2&3 and 6&7 will be dedicated to starts with general warm-up continuing in Lanes 4&5.** During sprints, swimmers will start from the deep end, exit the pool at the far end, and walk back to the start end. Lane assignments for warm-ups will be given to Team Representatives at least 24 hours prior to the meet. Warm-up information will be posted at the Clerk of Course area and the athlete bleacher area. Any swimmer without a coach of record will be assigned to warm-up with the host team.

ENTRY LIMITS: Individuals: Five (5) events per day, plus relays. A total of 11 individual events maximum for the meet. Entries will be limited to the first 3600 individual events plus relays. It is suggested that individual time trial events be limited to a maximum of 3 events for the meet.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries will be accepted and swimmers will be inserted in the first available lane, in order of deck entries received. There will be a maximum of, 1 additional heat a "0 Heat" created to accommodate deck entries. **Deck entries for the listed distance events will be accepted.**

POSITIVE CHECK IN
 Positive check in for Fridays distance events closes at 3:30 pm
 Positive check in for Saturday's OPEN 400 Free closes at 1 PM or 1 hour prior to the start of the meet. Positive Check in for the Sunday OPEN 400 IM will close at 1 PM or 1 hour prior to the start of the meet.

ENTRIES: If a team's total entries cause the meet total to exceed 3600 entries, that team's entries will be rejected. Entries will be considered according to the order of the electronic postmark. Teams whose entries are not accepted because the limit is exceeded will be notified by e-mail, and the fees will be returned.

ENTRY FORMS: All entries should be submitted via electronic format. Files compatible with Hy-Tek Meet Manager e.g. Cl2, Sd3, hvv format is the preferred procedure. . Any handwritten or printed entries must indicate the swimmer's name, sex, age, USAS#, event #., and time for each event .All entry times must be in long course meters. A NO TIME for an event will be accepted. All entry files must include the entry chair's name, phone #,

and e-mail contact information. Include the contact information of whom to send warm-up and final results. Each entry file will be followed up with an entry report for your review and confirmation. Coaches or a team representative must certify that all swimmers entered on the team roster are members of USA Swimming or have applied for membership by sending the appropriate application to the club's registration chairman or the OKS Registration Chairman before the first day of the meet.

Each team should make one check payable to: CHESAPEAKE SWIM CLUB or CSC for all entry fees. No individual checks will be accepted. Mail to above supplied address. Do not send any mail requiring signature confirmation for delivery.

ENTRY FEES: Entry fees are \$3.00 for individual events (62.5% or \$1.86 goes to OKS Aquatic Fund) and \$6.00 per relay (25% or \$1.50 goes to the OKS Aquatic Fund). There is a \$3.00 swimmer surcharge for the OKS Reserve Fund. Additionally, there will be a pool rental surcharge of 12.00 per swimmer. Total surcharge per swimmer is \$15.00. Time trials will be offered under Sanction # at the end of each Saturday and Sunday session, if time allows. It is suggested that the number of individual time trial events not exceed 3 for the duration of the meet. Deck entry individual event fees are \$5.00 with \$3.13 going to the OKS Aquatic Fund.. Relay event entry fees for DECK entries will be \$10.00 with \$2.50 going to the OKS Aquatic Fund. TIME TRIAL entry fees will be \$3.00 with \$1.86 going to the OKS Aquatic Fund. Make checks payable to the CHESAPEAKE SWIM CLUB or CSC. **NO INDIVIDUAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED, ONLY ONE CHECK FROM EACH CLUB.**

ENTRY DEADLINE: **ENTRIES MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE MEET DIRECTOR NO LATER THAN 6:00PM FRIDAY, JUNE 13, 2008. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!!! CHESAPEAKE SWIM CLUB WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INCLUSION OF ANY ENTRIES DELIVERED TO SOMEONE OTHER THAN THE MEET DIRECTOR.** Coaches must submit copies of their current certification, including USA Swimming, first aid, CPR and coach's safety training with their entries.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be given for the first eight (8) places in each of the age groups in the 12 and under session. Ribbons will be awarded for places 1-3 in relay events for the 12 and under swimmers.

SCORING: For the purposes of the team scoring, individual events will be scored as follows: 1st-9 points, 2nd-7points,3rd-6 points,4th- 5 points, 5th- 4 points, 6th-3 points, 7th- 2 points, 8th- 1 point. Relays will be scored at double the amounts for individual events: 1st-18 points, 2nd-14 points, 3rd-12 points, 4th-10 points, 5th-8 points, 6th-6 points, 7th- 4 points, 8th- 2 points.
Any 12-under who elects to swim an open event cannot also swim the same event in the 12- under session and score points.

RULES: The 2008 USA Swimming rules and the OKS Policy and Procedures Manual will govern the meet. ALL EVENTS ARE TIMED FINALS.

- SCRATCHES:** This will be a preseeded meet for all events except for the positive check in 1500 Free, 12- under 400 Free, Open 400 Free and Open 400 IM. These events will be deck seeded after the positive check in period closes. Failure to show for a positive checked in event will result in the forfeiture of the swimmers next individual event. It will be the swimmer's responsibility to report to their assigned heat and lane.
- FINAL RESULTS:** In accordance with OKS guidelines, final results will be posted on the OKS website (www.oks.org). Results of each day's events will be posted on the CSC web site. www.chesapeakeclub.org Complete results will be posted following the meet on the same site. All teams in attendance will be e-mailed complete results after the conclusion of the meet. Each team in attendance will be e-mailed a results file for Team Manager following the conclusion of the meet. Individuals may order copies of the final results at \$10 per copy by leaving their name and address with the Clerk of Course.
- HEAT SHEETS:** A list of all entrants with their times by event, heat and lane assignment for each day will be on sale for \$5.00 each. Deck seeded events will be shown in psych sheet format in the meet program. After deck seeding the distance events, a copy of the heat and lane assignments for athletes will be posted in the spectator area for visitors to access.
- CONCESSIONS:** A concession area will be available.
- MERCHANDISE:** A full supply of swim merchandise will be available for purchase.
- HOSPITALITY:** There will be a hospitality area available for officials and coaches working the Competition.
- SAFETY:** Activities in the pool area, which may result in injury, are prohibited. Safety marshals will be appointed to monitor the activities of swimmers and spectators during warm-ups and the meet. They are empowered by the safety rules of OKS to enforce the safety procedures governing this meet. Repeated violations or activities that are considered to be sufficiently dangerous may result in ejection from the meet. The use of camera phones for photographic purposes while in the locker rooms is strictly prohibited.
- POOL DECK ACCESS:** Access to the pool/deck area will be limited to athletes, coaches, officials, Timers and OKS certified representatives working the meet. Swimmers failing to comply with the above safety rules are subject to disqualification and /or expulsion from the meet at the discretion of the meet Referee. The walkway at pool deck level on the spectator side must be kept clear at all times. **Parents wishing to observe the competition must do so from the spectator area. Non-Athlete Registration cards do NOT grant parents access to the pool deck at any time.** Coaches must wear proof of current CPR, First Aid, and Coaches Safety Certification while on deck.
- CODE OF CONDUCT:** **Any individual who exhibits behavior of a threatening, abusive or derogatory manner toward an official or a member of the meet operations committee is subject to immediate removal and further expulsion from the meet. Coaches will be notified of the actions of their respective team's parents. Any one found to be misrepresenting themselves as a certified coach will be removed from the deck.**
- LIABILITY:** In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming Inc., Oklahoma Swimming Inc., all officials, the Chesapeake Swim Club, and Oklahoma City Community College shall be free from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct ion of the meet. Damage to the facility, when proven, will cause the offending swimmer or swimmers, if unattached, or the offending swimmer's club if attached to be accountable for repairs.
